<u>Gunner JOHN EDWARD HOPTON</u> 7044204, 11 (Honourable Artillery Coy.) Regt., Royal Horse Artillery who died age 26 on 14 November 1942 Son of Mr. and Mrs. E. Hopton; husband of B. Hopton, of Gloucester. Remembered with honour at the ALAMEIN MEMORIAL

There is no report of his death in the *Register* as far as I can research. However, the *CGWC* commemoration indicates clearly that he was killed during the *Battle of El Alamein*. However, because the battle lasted from 23 October to 4 November one can only surmise that this mobile artilleryman was killed either as a result of wounds sustained earlier or in the chase of Rommel's retreating army.
