The *Register* of 24 July 1943 reported the second blow for the family of Rev. Wigan of Puckrup Hall. In January 1943, his brother-in-law, **Col. Bernard**, had died and there followed this wasteful accidental loss.

At an enquiry held into the circumstances of the death of Capt Christopher Fredrick Henslowe Wigan, second son of the Rev P.F. and Mrs Wigan, of Puckrup Hall, who died from injuries sustained in a cycling accident, the coroner returned a verdict of accidental death, and found that no blame was attached to anybody. It appears that Capt Wigan was cycling when some soldiers suddenly stepped from the footpath, into his track, and in the collision was thrown, and sustained fatal injuries.
