We are very grateful to Celia Davey and the Strawford family for furnishing clues at the last minute to identify **Aldophus** rather than mere Harry Andrews. Singapore surrendered on the 15 February 1942 and the fact that he is commemorated upon a memorial suggests that his body was never recovered. This could mean that he, a member of the Medical Corps, was killed during the bombing of the *Alexandra Hospital*. Maybe he was lucky because that day and the next day the Japanese bayoneted to death staff and patients, in what is now known as the *Alexandra Hospital Massacre*.*
