Gloucestershire Dendrochronology Project: Tewkesbury

Tewkesbury contains a cluster of some of the best surviving, timber frame buildings in Gloucestershire. To help increase public understanding of this rich heritage and to map the chronology of early development, the Gloucestershire Dendrochronology Project has secured Heritage Funding to record and precisely date a number of buildings in Tewkesbury, through tree-ring dating.
